CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE

June 21, 2004 - 5 p.m. Meeting

MOTION TO CHANGE THE ORDER OF BUSINESS

Vice President Rawlings Blake made a motion, which was seconded, to invoke Rule 3-5(b) to change the usual order of business and to proceed with the order of business as reflected on the printed Meeting Agenda. The motion was approved.

THIRD READING

BILL NO. 04-1359 - An Ordinance reconstituting and reformulating the energy tax; ~~imposing an energy tax on persons who deliver, manufacture, or produce energy~~ repealing separate provisions for a fuel tax; defining certain terms; establishing certain rates; requiring certain reports to be made and records to be kept; imposing interest on unpaid taxes; imposing certain other civil and criminal penalties; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the imposition and collection of an energy tax.

BILL NO. 04-1354 REPORTED FAVORABLY AND ORDERED PRINTED FOR THIRD READING

Councilmember Rawlings Blake, for the Budget and Appropriations Committee and the Committee of the Whole, reported Bill No. 04-1354 favorably.

An Ordinance providing the appropriations estimated to be needed by each agency of the City of Baltimore for operating programs and capital projects during the fiscal 2005 year - Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2005.

Favorable report adopted, with Councilmember Stancil voting Nay.

The bill was read the second time and ordered printed for third reading.

AND ORDERED PRINTED FOR THIRD READING**

Councilmember Rawlings Blake, for the Budget and Appropriations Committee and the Committee of the Whole, reported Bill No. 04-1355 favorably.

An Ordinance providing a tax for the use of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for the period July 1, 2004, through June 30, 2005; and setting the semiannual payment service charge for that period - Property Tax rate.

Favorable report adopted.

The bill was read the second time and ordered printed for third reading.

The motion carried without exception, and the President declared the rules suspended with regard to the bills. Then Councilmember Rawlings Blake announced a hearing date for the bills.
