COUNCIL PRESIDENT TO HONOR CITY SCHOOLS 'TEACHER OF THE YEAR'

BALTIMORE—Today, Council President Stephanie Rawlings-Blake will join with City School System CEO Dr. Andrés Alonso to honor Mr. Nicholas Greer, Baltimore City's 'Teacher of the Year' at a City Council reception at City Hall. Mr. Greer, a 9th grade Biology Teacher at Baltimore Polytechnic Institute, was named Baltimore City Public Schools' 2009 'Teacher of the Year' on National Teacher's Day in May.

"Mr. Greer reminds us of the importance of having exceptional, dedicated and innovative teachers in every city classroom," Rawlings-Blake said. "On behalf of the entire Baltimore City Council, we are pleased to honor Mr. Greer with a Resolution in recognition of his achievement."
