**COUNCIL PRESIDENT RECEIVES  
MAYOR'S COMPREHENSIVE BUDGET PLAN**

**BALTIMORE, MD** – City Council President Bernard C. "Jack" Young today received Mayor Stephanie Rawlings-Blake's new budget and revenue-generating proposals.

Council President Young said he will work with his colleagues on Council during this budget process to preserve public safety, by preventing layoffs of police officers and fire workers, keeping recreation centers and swimming pools open and saving as many civil service jobs as possible.

Council President Young will announce tonight the creation of a new Recreation and Parks Subcommittee under the Public Safety Committee. The goal of the newly-created subcommittee will be to signal the Council's commitment to the city's young people and to seniors. Council President Young said he also wants to ensure that the system is providing effective and efficient services, while ensuring that the centers are clean, safe and providing the types of programs the community deserves.
