#### **Background**

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

- 1) Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
  - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
  - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
  - III. Made city government services more efficient;
  - IV. Made city government services more sustainable
- 2) Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
  - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
  - II. Population Growth;
  - III. Labor and Employment;
  - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses; and,
  - V. Community Benefit

#### **Commitments and Expenditures**

At the end of June, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has committed \$641.1 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for the benefit of Baltimore City residents. Through July 2023, about \$120.2 million dollars has been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 18.7% of the current commitments and of the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation. To ensure that all funds are obligated and expended by the statutory deadlines, the Recovery Office has started analysis of spend rates by commitment.

### **Commitments**

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments totaling \$641,170,126, the full Baltimore City ARPA allocation. Expenditures total \$120,155,599 through July 2023.

## **Recovery Office Accomplishments**

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs directly awarded ARPA funding to 45 nonprofit organizations. As of July 2023, all 45 nonprofits have received disbursements totaling \$15.7M. See Table 1 for information on total disbursements to nonprofits. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofit activities in July are as follows:

- Southeast CDC sold their first affordable home supported by ARPA funding. Additionally, SECDC's ARPA Home Repair program selected the first four homes for enrollment of critical, safety and code related repairs. Three of the four programs have been scoped and priced out.
- B360 successfully completed their first session of summer camp.
- Urban Strategies Inc. Baltimore provided wrap around services to Perkins, Somerset, and Oldtown residents including supporting the third cohort of their Job Readiness group graduation, providing utility assistance to six families, and preparing youth for an upcoming leadership training.

In addition, the Recovery Office continues to provide technical assistance to all funded city agencies, quasi government agencies and nonprofits as well as coordinating with centralized functions such as legal, procurement and finance to facilitate timely disbursements and expenditures.

## **Subawardee Accomplishments**

#### **Economic Recovery Fund**

There have been 1,019 grants awarded, totaling \$17,981,358, from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries, including nonprofits and small businesses (See Appendix for a complete list of organizations). Four out of five fiscal agents have completely disbursed grant funds. The fifth fiscal agent—Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC)—continues to disburse grants to its subrecipients. The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded by BDC through July 2023. A map including the locations of other Economic Recovery Fund recipients can be found on the Recovery Office dashboard.




Figure 1: Organizations Funded by Baltimore Development Corporation

#### Baltimore Civic Fund (BCF) Economic Recovery Assistance

BCF has completed all payments to nonprofit awardees and will not provide any additional updates until the 6-month and 12-month follow-ups are completed with its Round 2 beneficiaries.

#### **Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance**

In July 2023, BDC paid 26 businesses a total of \$199,735. Seventeen (17) of these businesses were awardees that received their first check, including one from Round 1 and 16 from Round 2. The information captured so far on the technical assistance activities with small businesses, beyond the provision of guidance for the ARPA application process has resulted in many

successes. For example, additional service resources were acquired from external local vendors that further support COVID-19 relief efforts for approximately 15 ARPA-funded small businesses in southeast Baltimore. Application assistance was provided to an additional 7 ARPA funded small businesses, with five of them successful in securing other loans and grants.

Several outreach and educational events are underway in August including:

- Empower Baltimore on 8/17/23
- How to start a business for women 8/22/23
- Atomic Goalsetting on 8/28/23
- The Black Business Month Meetup on 8/31/23.

## **City Agencies Accomplishments**

**Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)** 

BCRP completed the Wilbur Waters and Caroline & Hoffman court resurfacing projects in July, bringing the total number of BCRP projects completed to five. BCRP also added Briscoe Park athletic courts to the list of projects funded by ARPA.

The initial informal bid for the Gwynns Falls Trail project is still being processed, and BCRP has ordered equipment for eight playgrounds to be installed in the Fall, pending favorable weather.

The Towanda and Coldstream pool projects are still preparing to be bid for Summer 2023 and the Gardenville and Curtis Bay Recreation Center projects are finalizing schematic design.

#### **Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)**

BCHD has filled two open Baltimore Corps fellow positions for food insecurity work. The Covax team did 6 mobile clinics in July, vaccinating 99 people, including 2 days doing homebound vaccines for 16 people. The team also conducted 27 outreach events in July, reaching around 1,000 people.

#### **Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)**

On September 8, 2023, BDE will host a grantee Award Ceremony at Cahill Recreation Center to celebrate the inaugural cohort of Digital Equity Fund grantees. The Mayor's attendance has been confirmed. Five Town Hall meetings are scheduled for September: around 100 residents from various backgrounds will provide input on the city's digital equity strategy.

#### Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)

MOHS and DHCD continue to work collaborative and have now engaged HABC as a partner in the Housing Accelerator Fund. The Housing Accelerator Fund's Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) was released for public comment the week of August 7, 2023. The NOFA will assist in the creation of innovative funding mechanisms that will foster development of an expanded supply of permanent supportive housing units for individuals and families exiting chronic homelessness. In addition, MOHS actively participates in Continuum of Care (CoC) and other community workgroups, communities and meetings.

The Landlord Incentive and Flex Fund Subgrant Agreements have been finalized and are on track for the September 6, 2023, Board of Estimates meeting.

The Housing Navigator and Housing Identification Specialist positions have been filled. The staff positions are critical to the implementation and performance of the Housing Navigation and Landlord Engagement project which focuses on decreasing the amount of time people remain in crisis waiting to return to permanent housing.

#### Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)

#### Neighborhoods

The July 2nd mass shooting at Brooklyn Homes initiated MONSE's largest and most high-profile stabilization to date. The team engaged with at least 600 individuals over the first week and a half of the stabilization response activation. With the Peace Mobile stationed just outside the Brooklyn community center, staff were able to maximize their outreach potential during this most recent reporting period. During a proactive deployment in the Frankford community, MONSE staff successfully connected with several young men working their corners. Excited by the Peace Mobile's built-in recording studio, MONSE staff quickly established a rapport with these young men. Staff utilized this time to educate and connect individuals to a range of employment services, many for the first time. Accordingly, MONSE has developed an online form for communities to request the Peace Mobile, effectively streamlining the vehicle's internal schedule for future deployments. MONSE is also analyzing 311 service request data as part of each Coordinated Neighborhood Stabilization Response (CNSR) to improve MONSE's ability to track pre-existing requests, how many were added during CNSR safety walks and throughout the stabilization, and how many are completed.

On August 1, MONSE participated in this year's National Night Out program, as the Peace Mobile delivered on-site support at multiple partner locations throughout the evening. The team also helped facilitate the latest BMore Saturday Night Live event, with approximately 35-50 teens availing of Peace Mobile entertainment and staff support throughout the evening. Staff also distributed additional information on the Mayor's Violence Prevention Plan to adults in the area.

A 45-day stabilization response is currently underway in the Western district (1700 block on Carey Street). As part of this stabilization, MONSE also hosted a resource fair, checking to make sure that promises made through 311 are completed.

Lastly, Narcan training for city employees will soon be available through Workday. MONSE, in partnership with BCHD, held several monthly in-person and virtual trainings for city staff. In reviewing attendance and listening to feedback, MONSE determined that access to the training through Workday would increase accessibility. However, this transition does not mean that in-person sessions for larger groups are no longer available.

#### **Group Violence Reduction Strategy (GVRS)**

The Youth Advocate Programs, Inc (YAP) contract was recently submitted to BOE and is scheduled for review in September. The Technical Assistance contract is also scheduled to go before their September convening. In addition, MONSE was recently awarded additional funding from the Department of Juvenile Services (DJS) to help cover GVRS service costs for youth participants, including back-to-school supplies and housing/relocation funds. YAP staff are also now able to report directly into MONSE's case management system, rather than having to relay details for input.

#### **Community Violence Intervention (CVI)**

MONSE is currently developing workplan strategies so that CVI programs and partners can be better incorporated into CNSR. All calls or requests for CVI and/or Safe Streets support during a CNSR will now be routed through CVI Deputy Director, Crystal Miller, ensuring greater coordination and allocation of resources during the response. Additionally, the Safe Streets hiring process is ongoing. Three positions were recently added, bringing the total number of vacancies to 28. Two job offers have been made at two different sites, while other applicants are now going through round one vetting.

Safe Streets Safe Summer activities are ongoing and will continue through September, during which time various sites will begin supporting local youth as they prepare for back-to-school. Individual site programs and initiatives are to-be-determined; however, at this time we know of one site that will be facilitating a bookbag giveaway, complete with school supplies.

#### **Victim Services**

Several Victim Services grantees (like ROAR and TurnAround,Inc) were on hand to provide supportive services during the Coordinated Neighborhood Stabilization Response in Brooklyn.

#### **Finance**

The team recently held a community grant review meeting for 7th round of ARPA awards (our last round of ARPA funding). The meeting was held on July 11th, and MONSE expects those decisions to be made in August. No ARPA-funded agreements were approved in July.

#### Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs (MIMA)

#### **BNAAC**

MIMA onboarded a new implementing partner, Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Service (LIRS) Baltimore Welcome Center. This partner is in the process of hiring benefit navigators and has not yet enrolled clients. Southeast CDC's benefit navigators completed a 10-month long Case Manager Certificate Program this month provided by United Way of Central Maryland and

the University of Maryland School of Social Work. CASA is preparing to close out approximately 30 cases in August and working to ensure clients are prepared for close-out. Esperanza reported increases in inquiries for public charge consultations this month, however; overall numbers are still low.

In the past month outreach for the Baltimore New American Access Coalition included tabling at the St. Francis Community Day, the Mt. Clare National Night out, and Lakeland National night out.

In the coming month outreach roll out for LIRS will continue with an online information session on Facebook and a presentation at the Community Stakeholder call. Outreach in the next month will also occur at various back to school events and cultural events. These include talks and tabling at back-to-school sneak peaks at the following schools: Moravia, Morell Park. Furley, Fallstaff EMS, and the Mayor's Back to School backpack giveaway. BNAAC coalition members will have information tables at the Haitian Caribbean Festival, Folkloric Festival, and CASA's Resource fair.

#### **Language Access**

MIMA has primarily been working on project planning this month with the goal of initiating implementation in October 2023. The Language Access Project Manager has been supporting ongoing requests for language access services, including written translation of documents, but working with agencies to develop language access guidance documents and to train staff will begin in earnest in October. As part of project planning, MIMA has been meeting with language access coordinators of other municipalities to learn best practices, developing standard operating procedures, updating training content, and creating a SharePoint Teams site for interagency language access collaboration.

In July, MIMA attended a meet and greet event hosted by the Mayor's Office of Community Affairs. Community liaisons and outreach staff across city agencies gathered to share about their outreach work and to improve interagency collaboration. The Language Access Project Manager was able to share about ARPA language access support with representatives from DHCD, DOT, BCRP, MONSE, and more.

Additionally, MIMA shared the recent ARPA Insights article, that featured the BNAAC and Language Access Projects, in its monthly newsletter. Nearly 8,000 community members, community leaders, and City staff receive MIMA's newsletter every month.

#### Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)

#### **Impact Investment Area**

NOFA applications for developer incentives will open by mid-September. The NOFA for developer incentives recently closed its public comment period. DHCD has received 489 applications for homeowner incentives.

#### **Permitting Software Replacement**

Following the assessment of several vendors, a software vendor has been selected to provide a new software for both the ePermits and CHIP Inspections systems and the relevant agreement is expected to go to the Board of Estimates for their considerations and approval during their September 6th meeting. DHCD plans to re-engage with stakeholders regarding implementation process after BOE approval.

#### **Healthy Homes**

As a result of the application review process DHCD has identified approximately 3,500 applications submitted cumulatively since the portal opened. The need for assistance varies

from HVAC replacement to roof repair. Applicants range from low-to moderate-income homeowners who will receive assistance in many cases less than 90 days after approval.

#### **HUBS**

The Interagency Agreement between DHCD and MORP for The Older Adult Home Repair and Assistance Program (HUBS) will be finalized in August. The program will provide critical funding for adults 55 and older for home related issues such as repairs, health and safety improvements, and home security.

#### **Renters Right to Counsel**

The Interagency Agreement between DHCD and MORP for the Renter's Right to Counsel program will also be finalized in August. Funding will be used to provide information, education, and counseling on renter's rights before and during tenancy, and legal counsel during an eviction proceeding. It will also assist renters in forming tenant associations, and provide renters with referrals to additional health, social service, legal, financial and housing counseling services.

#### Department of Planning (DOP)

#### **Food Insecurity**

Online SNAP training for residents organized through the Resident Food Equity Advisory Program will start this Fall. This program represents a partnership with the Heart Smiles organization that will use Healthy Food Priority Area funds to create nutrition education. In addition, the online SNAP program assisted with handing farmers market vouchers at City senior centers.

The Food Insecurity team continues visits to produce distribution sites which are distributing approximately 119,000 pounds of produce monthly. DOP will also be hosting their Quarterly Food PAC meeting in September that brings together stakeholders from across Baltimore City's food system.

#### **Clean Corps**

Clean Corps has collected and disposed approximately 32 tons of waste throughout its selected neighborhoods over the course of this reporting period. The waste represents the results of cleaning alley ways and vacant lots.

DOP has also scheduled an Equipment Troubleshooting Class on September 15 and a Job and Resource Fair on September 22 for crewmembers and community residents.

#### **Department of General Services (DGS)**

#### **Baltimore Police Department (BPD) Fleet**

DGS is currently awaiting the delivery of the BPD fleet and expects the first batch of vehicles to be delivered in October 2023.

#### Department of Public Works (DPW) Load Packers

DGS Fleet ordered 20 Load Packers in June for DPW. This will help DPW reach its goal of reinstating weekly recycling. DGS expects that the vehicles will all be delivered by the end of 2024.

#### **HVAC Improvements at City Libraries**

DGS is still in the process of reviewing proposals to perform the Enoch Pratt Free Library (EPFL) HVAC Replacement work and a third-party mechanical, engineering and publishing consultant.

#### **Capital Improvements**

DGS is still finalizing the bid ready package for the Northwest Community Action Center and anticipates submitting to Contract Administration for review by the end of August.

DGS's final comments have been sent back to their consultants, who are now preparing the 100 percent bid-ready documents. Once received, the design team will review and will move on to bid prep. DGS anticipates a completed design submittal to be provided for review by early September.

#### **Performance Measures and Metrics**

A select number of performance measures are included in Table 3. Measures should not be viewed as underperforming since many programs or data collection are just beginning. The Recovery Office will continue to coordinate with subrecipients on measure accuracy. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented, and data becomes available. Other performance measures can be found on the dashboard and in the July 2023 Annual Recovery Plan Performance Report.
