Re: American Rescue Plan Funds – Performance Oversight Council Bill 21-0121 Monthly Report

#### Background

This memorandum accompanies the City of Baltimore Mayor's Office of Recovery Program's submission of its monthly report to the City Council on spending and performance related to American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding. Specifically, Council Bill 21-0121 § 49-2(B) prescribes the elements of legislatively required reporting, which stipulates that monthly reports should:

- 1) Provide data and metrics regarding how the funds have:
  - I. Increased the effectiveness of city government services;
  - II. Broadened the reach of city government services;
  - III. Made city government services more efficient;
  - IV. Made city government services more sustainable
- 2) Identify key performance indicators, benchmarks, and targets related to:
  - I. Equity, as defined in Article 1, § 39-1 of the Baltimore City Code;
  - II. Population Growth;
  - III. Labor and Employment;
  - IV. Economic Growth, especially the growth of minority and women-owned businesses; and,
  - V. Community Benefit

#### **Commitments and Expenditures**

At the end of June, the Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs has committed \$641.1 million in ARPA funds to City agencies, quasi-governmental organizations, and nonprofits to advance priority initiatives for the benefit of Baltimore City residents. Through June 2023, about \$109.9 million dollars has been spent on ARPA-funded projects (See Table 1), accounting for about 17.1% of the current commitments and of the city's \$641M total ARPA allocation. To ensure that all funds are obligated and expended by the statutory deadlines, the Recovery Office has started analysis of spend rates by commitment.

## Commitments

Table 1 lists ARPA commitments totaling \$641,170,126, the full Baltimore City ARPA allocation. Expenditures total \$109,923,447 through June 2023.

## **Recovery Office Accomplishments**

The Mayor's Office of Recovery Programs directly awarded ARPA funding to 45 nonprofit organizations. As of June 27, 2023, a total of 44 nonprofits have received disbursements totaling \$15.4M. See Table 1 for information on total disbursements to nonprofits. In addition, some highlights of select nonprofits' activities in June are as follows:


- ARPA funding has stabilized, supported, and expanded the International Rescue Committee's (IRC) caseload capacity. IRC has a record number of enrollments, many of which are from the past year and continuing into this year.
- Omega Baltimore Foundation's Flag Football and Fathers in the Hood Basketball League were highlighted as a Violence Prevention Initiative covered and broadcast on WJZ TV13.
- In June, ReBUILD Metro continued stabilization work on six scattered site abandoned properties in Johnston Square- completing interior demolition on four properties, with two more in progress. An additional two properties will be fully stabilized within the next month.


In addition, the Recovery Office continues to provide technical assistance to all funded city agencies, quasi government agencies and nonprofits as well as coordinating with centralized functions such as legal, procurement and finance to facilitate timely disbursements and expenditures.

## Subawardee Accomplishments

#### Economic Recovery Fund

Nine hundred sixty (960) grants, totaling \$17,781,623, have been awarded from Economic Recovery Fund fiscal agents to beneficiaries, including nonprofits and small businesses (See Appendix for a complete list of organizations). Four out of five fiscal agents have completely disbursed grant funds. The remaining fiscal agent—Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) continues to disburse grants to its subrecipients. The map below indicates the location of all organizations funded by BDC through June 2023. A map including the locations of other Economic Recovery Fund recipients can be found on the Recovery Office dashboard.

#### Baltimore Civic Fund (BCF) Economic Recovery Assistance

As of the end of June 2023, the Baltimore Civic Fund has completed all payments related to the Nonprofit Relief Fund. The second and final cohort of nonprofits completed the Technical Assistance program. BCF contracted with 20 Degrees LLC to provide two small cohorts of nonprofits with business and revenue coaching, group training, and technical assistance. Each of the two cohorts had 10 participants. Participating nonprofits received \$2,500 for participation. Three nonprofits out of these 20 participated in a pitch competition, which included additional financial awards of \$2,000, \$3,000, and \$5,000, respectively. There will not be any additional updates until BCF provides 6- and 12-month follow-ups on its Round 2 beneficiaries.

#### Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) Economic Recovery Assistance

In June 2023, BDC paid \$309,254 to 36 small business awardees. Twenty-five of those payments were 1<sup>st</sup> checks to Round 2 awardees (see Table 2 below). Three additional Round 1 businesses and eight Round 2 businesses received their final checks. BDC is also completing its six-month survey for all Round 1 small business grantees.

BDC's Technical Assistance Partners held community engagement and business outreach activities that included but were not limited to ARPA grantees. Activities included:

- CLLCTIVGIVE CLLCTIVLY is accepting applications for donations in honor of Black Philanthropy Month to support Baltimore's Black-led Social Change organizations.

## **City Agencies Accomplishments**

#### Baltimore City Recreation and Parks (BCRP)

The renovation of Johnston Square and Luzerne Avenue Park athletic court projects were completed. BCRP also completed the Middle Branch Trail project which involved surveying work. BCRP also began the Wilbur Waters and Caroline & Hoffman athletic court projects.

BCRP has also initiated a bid for the Gwynns Falls Trail project and is in the process of ordering equipment for eight playgrounds. The Towanda and Coldstream pool projects are still preparing to be bid for Summer 2023 and the Gardenville and Curtis Bay Recreation Center projects are finalizing schematic design.

#### Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD)

The Adult Guardianship team hired one staff member and made official offers to two Baltimore Corps candidates for case worker positions for a targeted start date of early August.

The Vaccination team held 28 clinics with 168 COVID-19 vaccine doses administered. The VALUE Communities team, with the assistance of Clinical Health Workers (CHWs) from the Mobile Response Team, attended 33 outreach events in June, interacting with approximately 1,702 people.

The Chief Medical Officer participated on a panel focused on COVID-19, and communications staff prepared a briefing and talking points Chief Medical Officer submitted letter to the editor regarding post-Covid Medicaid changes.

#### Broadband and Digital Equity (BDE)

Between February 2023 and July 2023, BCIT has engaged approximately 1,032 people over the course of 111 hours. The events have been designed around sharing information with stakeholders. The community engagement strategy centered on:

- Assessing community perceptions of the City and its efforts in the digital ecosystem;
- Socializing concepts and perspectives of resources in the digital ecosystem;
- Identifying potential partners who were not currently connected to the City's work in the digital ecosystem; and
- Using ethnographic methods to identify residents' perspectives on the root causes of digital inequity and segregation in Baltimore.

Each organization was provided information on digital resources and worked with City staff to plan more in-depth support for the City or its partners. Below is a list of organizations that were engaged between May 2023 and July 2023.

#### Mayor's Office of Employment Development (MOED)

A total of 783 participants enrolled in Train Up Occupational Skills Training, of whom 302 are with City ARPA-funded programs. In total (including City and State ARPA-funded programs), 250 enrollees have obtained certifications, 371 have completed their training and 216 have gained employment with an average hourly wage of \$18.50. About 315 enrollees are still in training and the remaining completers are still in their job search phase.

A total of 245 unemployed/underemployed Baltimore City residents have received subsidized employment through Hire Up. Of these, 124 are funded by City ARPA. Including State-funded slots, 88 of those who remained in the program at least two weeks have transitioned to unsubsidized employment, with 83 of reporting an entry wage of \$15/hour or higher. MOED has developed partnerships with the following worksites: the Baltimore City Department of Transportation, Department of Finance, Baltimore City Recreation and Parks Department, Department of Public Works, Parking Authority of Baltimore City, Downtown Partnership of Baltimore, Baltimore City Health Department, and the Mayor's Office of African American Male Engagement (MOAAME), and Hoodfellas restaurant. MOED also serves as a worksite.

Hire Up and Train Up Project Managers continue to coordinate with two legal services providers, Maryland Legal Aid and Maryland Volunteer Lawyers Service as well as Associated Catholic Charities to provide behavioral health services. To date, at least 285 participants have taken advantage of free legal services; 175 participants have received group or individual behavioral health services.

Through the Small Business Wage Subsidy, a total of 659 unemployed or underemployed residents have been hired at small, minority- or woman-owned businesses, and 456 subsidies have been paid to businesses thus far (paid upon 10 weeks of employment). Ninety-six percent of impacted business owners state they intend to hire their new staff permanently after 10 weeks and have reported retention of these employees at rates of 80% after 6 months of hiring and an average wage of \$21.38. According to the survey that was conducted for businesses that received the subsidy, the majority of benefiting businesses stated that they reinvested the subsidy to raise salaries and hire more people.

During the 2023 registration period over 11,522 youth applied for Summer Youthworks. The 5week program will operate from July 10 to August 11. This year MOED offered employment to 7,890 youth, covering 591 worksites—120 more employers than last year. YouthWorks Academy took place between February 6 and May 5 – with 104 youth completing the Academy. The Youth Advisory Council began March 13 and employs 10 youth as staff advising the Youthworks team. The YouthWorks team is gearing up for Year-round Internships which will start this coming school year.

#### Mayor's Office of Homeless Services (MOHS)

As in prior months, MOHS and DHCD actively engage in the Continuum of Care (CoC) which is a HUD sponsored program designed to promote community-wide commitment to the goal of ending homelessness and provide funding for efforts by nonprofit providers, state and local governments. Main goals of this program include using a coordinated entry system that promotes participant choice, utilizing evidence-based strategies to create performance measures and outcome data, and promoting access to mainstream benefits and prioritizing employment opportunities among others.

Community outreach will be conducted prior to the release of the Housing Accelerator Fund Notice of Funding Announcement (NOFA). A communication plan has been developed and MOHS is working in collaboration with DHCD. MOHS has also worked on the following activities:

- Implementing the homeless response diversion program by September.
- Preparing two sub-agreements for BOE approval
- Implementing the Landlord Engagement Initiative as approved by the BOE
- Releasing the Housing Accelerator Fund NOFA by the end of August.

#### Mayor's Office of Neighborhood Safety and Engagement (MONSE)

**Community Violence Interventions** – Safe Summer is ongoing, and MONSE is currently hiring for the following Safe Streets positions in partnership with Community Based Organization (CBOs) Catholic Charities and Lifebridge Health: Site Directors, Site Supervisors, and Violence Interrupters. Safe Summer activities are planned from July through September 2023 and are as follows:

**Finance** – The request for applications to the Neighborhood Policing Plan closed on June 14th, garnering 13 applications. MONSE will begin reviewing applications and will select a recipient soon. MONSE also received 11 applications for available CBO grants through its portal and will be convening a community grant review meeting to evaluate those applications. In addition, the following contracts received BOE approval in June:

**Group Violence Reduction Strategy (GVRS)**– MONSE successfully carried out its first call-in from the Southwestern District. Under GVRS, most direct communications currently employed in community are intended for those at highest risk of perpetrating or being the victims of gun violence. These communications are intended for the individual and designed to address their needs and/or concerns on a 1:1 basis. However, it is imperative that members of the community feel empowered to perform a "call-in," wherein small groups of residents convene to discuss needs, concerns, or calls for support. MONSE wishes to ensure that every GVRS-implemented district understands the process for identifying the local community group(s) that are most appropriate to facilitate a call-in, as well as the logistics associated with planning and executing a call-in. In addition, MONSE is also planning bi-annual GVRS training for BPD (including the Group Violence Unit), as well as other community and civic partners engaged in the work.

GVRS hosted a Resource Fair on Friday, June 30th, as part of its ongoing community stabilization within the 1600-1700 blocks of Carey Street in the Western District. This stabilization was initiated following the recent law enforcement takedown of a GVRS target in the area. An additional stabilization is planned for Washington Boulevard in the Southwestern District and will be carried out over the coming weeks.

**Community Engagement & Opportunity (CE&O)** – In June during Gun Violence Awareness Month, MONSE introduced and deployed the Peace Mobile, a fully outfitted vehicle replete with easy-access resource support for individuals and families and with entertainment. The Peace Mobile averages 15 to 50 participant interactions per deployment.

The Peace Mobile was deployed as part of the proactive Frankford Coordinated Neighborhood Stabilization Response (CNSR) at the start of June, which saw particularly high engagement among the community's senior residents, many of whom stay aboard the bus throughout the day. In addition to Frankford, the Peace Mobile was also featured at this year's AFRAM festival, as well as Lexington Market. These mobilizations provide a unique opportunity to connect with residents and perform simple, effective public safety surveys in diverse communities across the city.

Throughout the month of June, the Peace Mobile participated in several community resource fairs and outreach events, most notably in Penn North, participated in a joint resource fair/GVRS response in the Penn North community, the Robert C. Marshall Recreation Center resource fair, and finalized MONSE's Westport CNSR response in Maisel Court following a local youth-involved shooting. As part of this response, the team successfully engaged with and delivered resource support for 32 students.

MONSE will also be continuing CNSR efforts in the Brooklyn community following the recent mass shooting. We Our Us (CNSR grantee) held a community walk/vigil with Brooklyn including faith leaders and members of the community. ROCA (CNSR grantee) mobilized and will be working to connect with victims and help ensure that young people are getting connected to services. Peace Movement (CNSR grantee) will also be on hand as part of the 45-day process. Support from partners and grantees, also includes Safe Streets Brooklyn, UMD, Let's Thrive Baltimore, and Challenge to Change.

#### Mayor's Office of Immigrant Affairs (MIMA)

**Baltimore New Americans Access Coalition (BNAAC):** MIMA successfully concluded contract negotiations with Lutheran Immigration & Refugee Service (LIRS) Welcome Center and have begun the process of onboarding. In addition, the Welcome Center has begun the hiring process for 2 full-time navigators.

In June, MIMA held information sessions on its Facebook page, hosted a a resource Fair with LIRS to promote BNAAC, hosted an information table at Latino Fest, and visited African owned businesses in Baltimore with the Esperanza/IOSC Benefit Navigator.

BNAAC will host an information table at the St. Francis Community Day, the Mt. Clare National Night Out, and the Lakeland National Night Out. In addition, the team will begin the outreach roll out for LIRS by doing an online information session on MIMA's Facebook page, conduct a presentation during the Community Stakeholder call and engage in outreach at events like the St. Francis Community Day.

**Language Access:** MIMA hosted its quarterly Language Access Oversight Committee on June 7, where the new Language Access Project Manager was introduced and provided an overview of upcoming project initiatives.

#### Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD)/Housing

#### **Healthy Homes**

The Healthy Homes project has taken major strides with community engagement including meetings, home visits, and door-to-door visits in different neighborhoods. The program has approximately 3,000 submitted applications for home repair assistance to date from low-to-moderate-income homeowners for issues including:

- HVAC repair
- Mold remediation
- Roof repairs
- Indoor air quality

#### HUBS

DHCD is in the final stages of agreement execution for The Older Adult Home Repair and Assistance Program (HUBS). The program focuses on the senior population for assistance for home related issues such as repairs, health and safety improvements, and home security.

#### IIANRF

The Impact Investment Neighborhood Relief Fund has begun submitting BOE memos for ARPA acquisitions to obtain titles for properties within the seven impact investment areas. The application for the ARPA developer incentives is in the final stages and will be made available to the public in the coming months.

#### Department of Planning (DOP)

#### **Food Insecurity**

The Food Policy team continues to visit its network of 32 sites that distribute on average 8,800 produce boxes (130,000 pounds of produce) to residents each month. These visits have

fostered rapport with community partners and provide an opportunity to share feedback. The produce sites also receive weekly recipes, produce guides, nutrition education and a feedback survey to inform program performance and satisfaction among residents.

#### **Clean Corps**

DOP with collaboration from the Recovery Office arranged for the filming of two Clean Corps sites to highlight the cleaning and greening activities of Clean Corps crews and the impact on neighborhoods. The footage is currently under review and will be available in the coming months.

#### Department of General Services (DGS)

#### Baltimore Police Department (BPD) Fleet:

DGS is currently awaiting the delivery of the BPD fleet and expects the first batch of vehicles to be delivered in October 2023.

#### Department of Public Works (DPW) Load Packers:

DGS Fleet ordered 20 Load Packers in June for DPW. This will help DPW reach its goal of reinstating weekly recycling. DGS expects that the vehicles will all be delivered by the end of 2024.

#### HVAC Improvements at City Libraries:

Within the past month, DGS has received a proposal from a contractor to perform the Enoch Pratt Free Library (EPFL) HVAC Replacement work and a third-party mechanical, engineering and publishing consultant. These proposals are currently under review by DGS and EPFL.

#### **Capital Improvements**:

DGS will use \$2.5 million to renovate the Northwest Community Action Center. The center provides low-income residents access to energy, water, and rental assistance programs. The building renovation is a comprehensive improvement to bring the site up to City code and the latest ventilation standards. As of June 2023, the design is 100% complete. DGS is finalizing the bid ready package and anticipates submitting to Contract Administration for review by the end of August.

DGS will use an additional \$6.85 million for City Hall preservation and restoration work to fix leaks and maintain the building's integrity. The project covers all roof and building envelope systems. As of June 2023, the design consultant is incorporating comments from DGS and proceeding to the 100% design phase for the project. DGS anticipates a completed design submittal to be provided for review by early September.

### **Performance Measures and Metrics**

A select number of performance measures are included in Table 3. Measures should not be viewed as underperforming since many programs or data collection are just beginning. The Recovery Office will continue to coordinate with subrecipients on measure accuracy. Additional data on performance measures will be included in Council reports as programs are further implemented, and data becomes available. Other performance measures can be found on the dashboard and in the July 2023 Annual Recovery Plan Performance Report.
